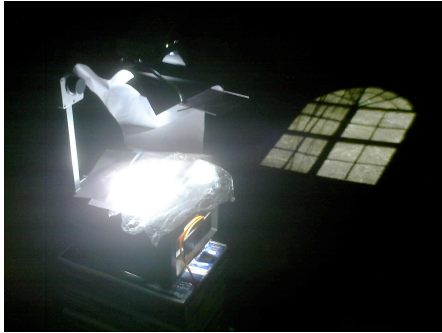


# ANNABEL-LANGE-WINDOW

## **description**

An overhead projection on a white wall. The shape of the projected image associates the presence of a big window.

## **comment by the artist**

In this installation the central point is to imitate the aesthetic of Annabel Langes work which was itself inspired by Ólafur Elíassons work. As in my earlier videography "Andreas Lorenschat Tower, Helsinki, 2006" this projection deals with imitation and appropriation of artistic handwriting.

## **presentation**

Projection on floor or/and wall in a room with an entrance situation. Like that the projector is not perceived at first and the visitor expects a window in the room.

## **technical requirements**

Overhead projector, light mask to imitate the frame of a window.
